Safety Related Changes

Dimetapp Chesty Cough Elixir (**guaiphenesin**, **bromhexine hydrochloride**) is now contraindicated in children under 6 years.

Dimetapp PE Nasal Decongestant (phenylephrine hydrochloride) is now contraindicated in children under 12 years.

Gilenya (fingolimod) is now contraindicated in patients who in the last 6 months experienced myocardial infarction, unstable angina, stroke, TIA or decompensated heart failure requiring hospitalization or class III/IV heart failure; a history or presence of Mobitz Type II second-degree or third-degree atrioventricular (AV) block or sick sinus syndrome, unless the patient has a functioning pacemaker; a baseline QTc interval \geq 500 ms; and concomitant treatment with class IA or III anti-arrhythmic drugs during Gilenya initiation.

Vytorin (ezetimibe and simvastatin) is now contraindicated with the use of voriconazole and fusidic acid.
