

Safety Related Changes

In patients using Apo-Trandalopril (**trandalopril**), coadministration with aliskiren in patients with diabetes is now contraindicated.

Duocover (**clopidogrel and aspirin**) is now contraindicated in those patients with pre-existing mastocytosis, in whom the use of acetylsalicylic acid may induce severe hypersensitivity reactions (including circulatory shock with flushing, hypotension, tachycardia and vomiting).

Natrilix (**indapamide**) is now contraindicated in hypokalaemia, severe renal failure and hepatic encephalopathy or severe impairment of liver function.
