New Indications

Humira (adalimumab (rch)) is indicated for the treatment of moderate to severe ulcerative colitis in adult patients who have had an inadequate response to conventional therapy or who are intolerant to or have medical contraindications for such therapies.

Stromectol (ivermectin) is now indicated in crusted scabies in conjunction with topical therapy and in human sarcoptic scabies when prior topical treatment has failed or is contraindicated.
