

New Products - Tecdifera

Tecdifera (**dimethyl fumarate (DMF)**) is an immunomodulator. Nonclinical studies indicate that pharmacodynamic responses to DMF appear to be mediated, at least in part, through activation of the Nuclear factor (erythroid-derived 2)-like 2 (Nrf2) transcriptional pathway, which is a critical cellular defence system for responding to a variety of potentially toxic stimuli through up-regulation of antioxidant response genes. The mechanism by which DMF exerts therapeutic effects in multiple sclerosis is not fully understood. Tecdifera is indicated in relapsing MS to reduce relapse frequency and delay disability progression. Tecdifera is available as 120 mg capsules in blister packs of 112's and 240 mg capsules in blister packs of 56's.
